PROJECT DESCRIPTION: With an eye toward future flexibility for incorporating emerging technologies, the \$13.5 million project effectively accommodates MVRBC’s three principle functional areas: Collections, processing (includes testing and component labs, distribution and inventory management, and mobile staging area) and admission.

IMPACT™ BENEFITS: The IMPACT agreement brought precision and focus to the project, which was necessary for the transitional move of uninterrupted operations from the blood center’s former location to the new facility.
